What information we collect, use, and why?

We collect or use the following information to **provide services and goods**, **including delivery**:

 - Health and safety information

 - Records of meetings and decisions

We collect or use the following information to **comply with legal requirements**:

- Criminal offence data (including Disclosure Barring Service (DBS), Access NI or Disclosure Scotland checks)
- Health and safety information

We collect or use the following information for **recruitment purposes**:

- Contact details (eg name, address, telephone number or personal email address)
- National Insurance number
- Copies of passports or other photo ID

- Employment history (eg job application, employment references or secondary employment)
- Education history (eg qualifications)
- Right to work information
- Details of any criminal convictions (eg Disclosure Barring Service (DBS), Access NI or Disclosure Scotland checks)
- Security clearance details (eg basic checks and higher security clearance)

We get our personal information from people directly including students and parents/guardians.

How long we keep information

Off Beat Dance and Off Beat Dance Academy will store you information safely for as long as you remain a student at our classes. As a member of Off Beat Dance Academy, when you notify us of a student leaving, we will keep your information for a period of 6 months after the departure. As a member of Off Beat Dance (Adult Classes) – we will keep your information for a year after your last visit to our classes. We will indefinitely retain images and videos for marketing purposes unless we receive a request for removal from our storage

We share our information with:

- Insurance companies
- Emergency services (where necessary)
- Publicly on our website, social media or other marketing and information media (where appropriate)

Your data protection rights

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

Your right of access - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal data.

Your right to rectification - You have the right to ask us to rectify personal data you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.

Your right to erasure - You have the right to ask us to erase your personal data in certain circumstances.

Your right to restriction of processing - You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances.

Your right to object to processing - You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances.

Your right to data portability - You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal data you gave us to another organization, or to you, in certain circumstances.

Your right to withdraw consent – When we use consent as our lawful basis you have the right to withdraw your consent.

You don't usually need to pay a fee to exercise your rights. If you make a request, we have one calendar month to respond to you.

How to complain
